Youth Centre Receives NB Children's Foundation Grant

The Chipman Youth Centre Inc. has received a \$20,000 grant from the New Brunswick Children's Foundation. The funds will be used to help the Centre retain a full time co-ordinator and for the continuation of the Respect and After-school programs. CYC is thankful for their continued support.

The NB Children's Foundation's roots stretch back to the mid-1800s, first as the Saint John Protestant Orphans' Home Asylum. In 1922, the name was changed to the New Brunswick Protestant Orphans' Home. In 1978, the incorporation act was changed to allow the Orphanage to award financial grants to other charitable organizations in New Brunswick that help or care for children in the province. Since that time the Foundation has awarded over \$15 million to organizations and charities who support the needs of children throughout the province.
